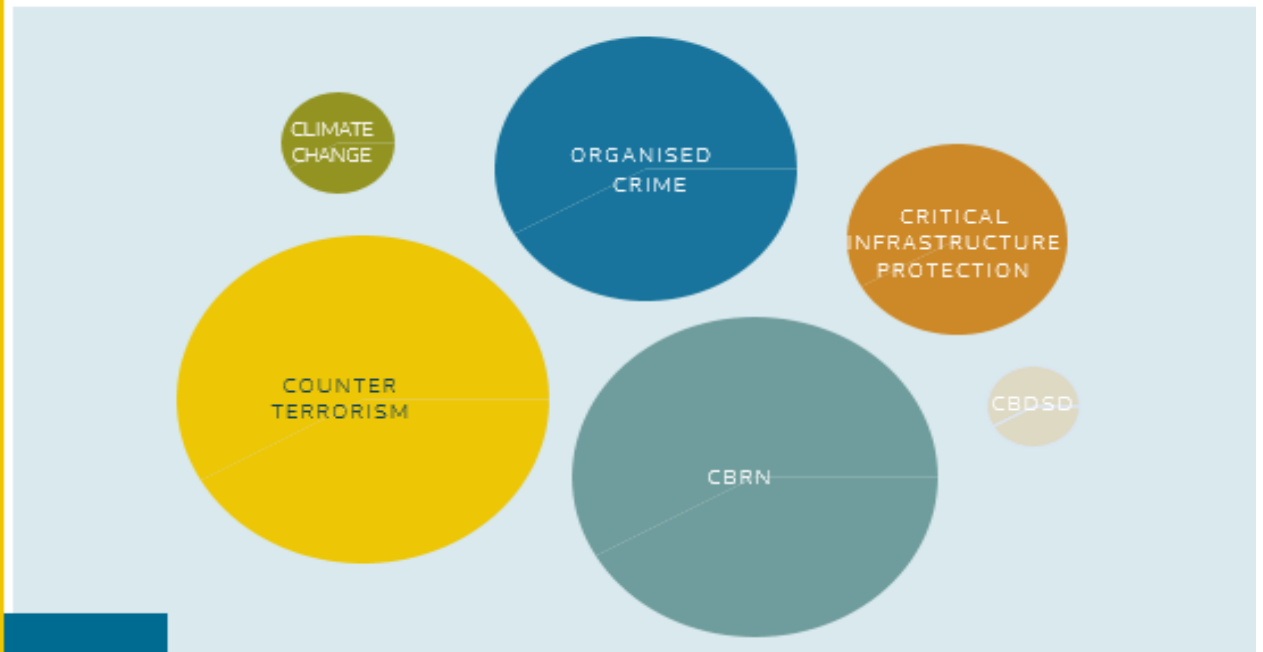

# Election Observation Missions (EOMs)



Priorities set annually by the HRVP, after consultations with Member States and the EP

Deployed upon invitation from the country where the election takes place

EOMs cover all phases of the election cycle: **pre-election, election day, and immediate post-election**



**FPI** is responsible for the administrative, financial and security aspects of EOMs

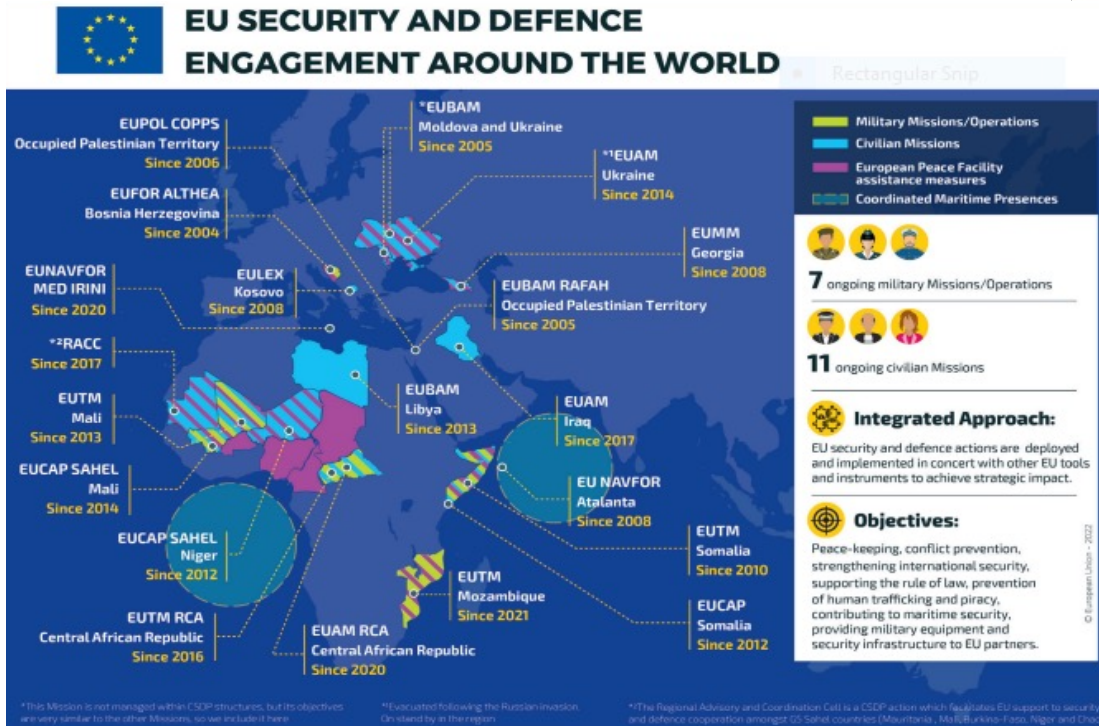
*Duty of Care* towards all Mission members

**EEAS** is responsible for the policy aspects of EOMs.

In charge of programming the priorities for election observation, which is led by the HRVP

- In 2023, 12 operational **civilian** CSDP
- Mandates agreed by Member States.
- **FPI drafts a Budgetary Impact Statement (BIS)**, based on the Missions' Operational Plan (OPLAN).

- Independent entities representing the EU in key regions and countries.
- Accountable to the Commission for the use of their funds.
- **9 EUSRs** currently supporting HRVP Joseph Borrell (*regional & thematic basis*).

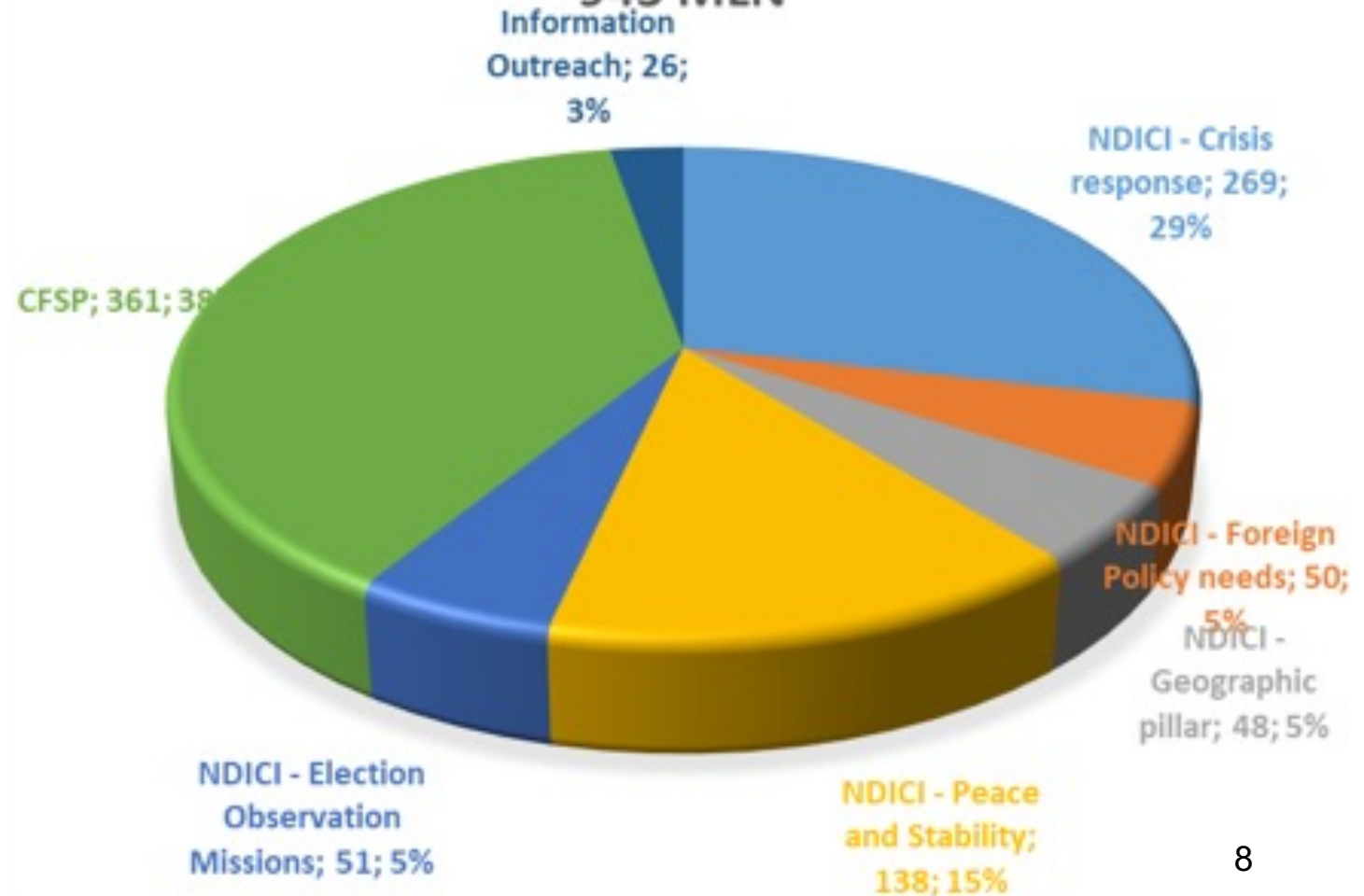

- ❖ Peacebuilding and support to youth in the Swahili Coast (CEFA Consortia, €2M, ends March 2026; multi-country: KEN, MOZ, TZ)
- ❖ Inclusive Participation in Peace and Security (IPPS) in the border area of Mozambique and Tanzania (GiZ, €4M, ends Sept 2025)
